We are a private, not-for-profit membership organisation, voted for by the city's businesses in June 2016. Since then, we have collectively invested over £7.5million into making Cardiff more welcoming, vibrant, and influential through award-winning campaigns, projects, and initiatives.



So, what's the task?

A simple welcome — in any language — makes you feel at home, so we want you to create a piece that you feel relates to the theme of "Welcome".

Our city is a melting pot of different cultures – so we want the next generation of students to feel connected to Cardiff and like they're at home. Therefore, all pieces should feel welcoming, inclusive and positive.

What you'll deliver:

Character design, illustration, and photography are just some of the ways this can be demonstrated.

A pdf document of no more than 10 pages outlining your concept and final pieces.

This can be something you've already created or an entirely new project — it's up to you!

So, get creative, express your style, embody the spirit of the city, and champion what 'welcome' means to you — and how it appeals to the next generation of students.

Work must be submitted by Monday 25th July, 12pm. Shortlisted entries will be notified by Friday 29th July. The campaign will be live from September 2022.
